Richard B. Saltman is Professor of Health Policy and Management at the Emory University School of Public Health in Atlanta, Georgia. He is also a research director and a member of the Secretariat for the European Observatory on Health Care Systems, an international partnership based at the WHO Regional Office for Europe in Copenhagen. From 1991 to 1994, he was Director of the Department of Health Policy and Management at Emory. Previously he was Associate Professor at the University of Massachusetts School of Public Health (1985 - 1994) and Research Associate in Political Science at Harvard School of Public Health (1980 - 1985). He holds a doctorate in political science from Stanford University.

He has published 12 books and over 100 articles on a wide variety of health policy topics, particularly on the structure and behavior of European health care systems, and his work has been widely translated. He has held two Fulbright Fellowships as well as research fellowships from the German Marshall Fund of the United States and from the Kellogg Foundation. In 1987 and again in 1999, he won the European Health Management Association's annual prize for the best publication in health policy and management in Europe.
